## Rules:

- Each school may register up to five students per grade level in each individual event. A student
  may participate in up to four events, but only at their own grade level or higher (no student may
  enter an event below their grade level). Priority will be given to schools that submit their
  registration information first. Registration will open in August, and we will do our best to
  accommodate all participants.
- Each school must be accompanied by a faculty advisor, instructor, or math coach. Advisors may be asked to help grade tests or supervise students as needed. Students must be present at the designated location when their event begins, as timers will be set to end the tests on time.
- Testing time will be 15 minutes with a 5-minute break between events. Accuracy and time will both be factors in determining winners. In case of a tie, the first student to submit their test will place higher. If the tie remains, the tests will be reviewed question by question. The first person to miss loses the tie. If this does not determine the tiebreaker, a coin will be flipped and/or names drawn from a hat.
- Calculators will NOT be allowed on any tests! Cell phones will not be allowed out in the testing rooms. Cheating of any kind will forfeit the test. This includes the presence of a cell phone in the testing rooms. Pencils must be brought by the student, but scratch paper will be provided for each test. Students need to remember to enter all answers on the answer sheets since only answer sheets will be graded (and students will not be allowed to transfer answers to answer sheets after time has been called). Both test and answer sheet will be handed in. Marking on the main test is not preferred nor needed.
- Lunch will begin after the last test is finished. However, you may start lunch early if you have no participants in the last test or if you are eating on campus. Dining Hall hours for Lunch is 11:30-1:15pm.
- Fort Scott Community College reserves the right to cancel any event and to limit participation if necessary.

## Awards:

- Individual medals will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each event at each grade level during the closing assembly. It is expected that the participant in any event must get at least one correct answer to place in the event.
- The awards ceremony will be at 1:00 pm in the Ellis Fine Arts Center to hand out the medals and congratulate the winners.
