Survey of historical and literary aspects of the Hebrew scriptures as found in the Old Testament, with emphasis on development of religious ideas and monotheistic practice, outstanding personalities and Judaic influences on modern-day Christianity.

REL1093, WORLD RELIGIONS T►, 3

hours.

This course examines the origin and development of primitive religion and the major world religions, including Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Confucianism, Taoism and primal religions; including analyses of the philosophical bases of religious tenets through examinations of sacred writings.
