

ADMISSIONS & APPLICATIONS

Become a Greyhound in 4 steps!

1. APPLY <u>Apply</u> to FSCC by filling out the online application form. Ensure you have all necessary documents for submission.



2. FINANCIAL AID Explore <u>financial aid</u> options and complete the FAFSA form. Contact the financial aid office for assistance and details on available scholarships.



3. VISIT Schedule a campus <u>visit</u> to explore FSCC facilities and meet with the admissions staff. A great opportunity to ask questions and see the campus firsthand



4. ENROLL Complete your <u>enrollment</u> process by meeting with an advisor and registering for classes. Ensure your schedule is set up for the upcoming semester.





Transcripts & Registrar Information

Transcripts

Official high school and college transcripts must be mailed directly from the sending institution or sent by an electronic transcript service directly to Fort Scott Community College, or hand delivered in a sealed envelope. The hand delivered transcript must be placed in the school letterhead envelope with the Registrar's signature or school stamp imprinted on the sealed back flap. Opening the envelope will render that transcript invalid.

Fort Scott Community College will accept both emailed and faxed official high school transcripts directly from the high school.

No transcripts will be accepted from the student. All transcripts must be sent directly from the sending institution to FSCC.

For high school transcripts to be considered official they must have a graduation date and a signature and/or school seal.

The FSCC Advising Office provides students with professional, confidential academic advisement. FSCC Advisors can help students with enrolling in classes, tutoring services, and other common needs. The advising offices are located in Bailey Hall and are open Monday-Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. To set up an appointment, call 620-223-2700, ext. 3630.

To fulfill each student's academic needs, we recommend that all students meet with an FSCC advisor each semester. However, all of the following students MUST meet with an FSCC advisor to ensure the students' academic needs and goals are being met: first-year, transfer, high school students, students on financial aid probation or suspension, students enrolled in developmental courses, and student-athletes.

- Free tutoring is available to all students. Our peer tutor program
 is designed to help students who are experiencing difficulties in
 a particular course. Peer tutors are high-performing students
 who have received training in tutoring policies and techniques.
- Test accommodations are available for students who qualify for accommodations. Services offered include test reading, extended test time, and a non-distracting environment.
- Test proctoring is available to students for approved online classes and make-up tests.
- Quality technology is available to all students through the use of computers. Whether it's typing term papers, checking email, or surfing the internet, students are always welcome to use our computers for personal or educational use.
- Assessment testing is available for any prospective student.
 This FSCC placement test is similar to the ACT and aids in placing students in the correct course for their skill level.

Three Systems, one portal - Student Portal

- 1. Go to www.fortscott.edu
- 2. Click on the "Student Portal" at the top
- 3. In the Student Portal, you will see "MYFSCC Login, Student Email, and Blackboard Login"

Logging into Blackboard: Blackboard is our learning management system. Students can access course material, assignments and grades. They can also communicate with peers and instructors. For "Username," enter your Student ID #, then enter your password (Last four of your social security #). If the last four start with a zero, then enter the last three digits.

Logging into Student Email: Enter your Username (first initial_last name_last four digits of student ID #@students.fortscott.edu, i.e. j_wheeler_1234@students.fortscott.edu). Your initial Password is Hounds(last 4 of your Student ID) Ex. Hounds1234. It is recommend you change your password to your personal preference after initial log in. *Contact Advising for password reset.

<u>Logging into MYFSCC</u>: MYFSCC is your Student Account. Enter student ID # in the username box, then it will take you to your email and you will enter your student email credentials.


