### Police Science

#### Associated of Applied Science

A program that prepares individuals to perform the duties of police and public security officers, including patrol and investigative activities, traffic control, crowd control and public relations, witness interviewing, evidence collection and management, basic crime prevention methods, weapon and equipment operation and maintenance, report preparation and other routine law enforcement responsibilities. The AAS in Police Science is designed to prepare students for entry-level employment in the criminal justice field or for transfer to a four-year institution for continued study. Students explore a broad range of topics such as criminal procedures, criminal law, investigations, interviewing techniques, report writing, and law enforcement. Students pursuing the AAS are required to complete KLETC or equivalent law enforcement academy training.
