## Eligibility:

- Admission to the associate degree in nursing program at Fort Scott Community College
- Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.50
- Completion of 60 credit hours of prerequisite courses, including:
  - English Composition I & II
  - Ethics
  - Humanities elective
  - Public Speaking or Interpersonal Communication
  - General Psychology
  - General Sociology
  - Human Development
  - General Chemistry with lab
  - Microbiology with lab
  - Human Anatomy with lab
  - Physiology (or a combined A&P course)
  - Pathophysiology
  - Human Nutrition
  - College Algebra
  - Statistics
  - PLUS:
    - Additional elective credits as needed to reach the 60-credit hour minimum.

## How to Apply:

- First, apply to FSCC's nursing program. (You will need a copy of that admission letter for your KU application.)
- Then, apply to the KU School of Nursing.
  - The application is online at <https://gograd.ku.edu/apply/>
  - Application Deadlines:
    - Fall Start, Application open February 1 to July 1
    - Spring Start, Application open July 2 to December 1
    - Apply early to maximize your chances for scholarship opportunities
  - KU application requires a copy of your associate degree in nursing admission letter, official transcripts from every college attended, three letters of reference, a resume, and a \$75.00 application fee.
