

Prerequisite Transfer Guide:

Fort Scott Community College and University of Kansas Nursing Partnership

ELIGIBILITY:

- Admission to the Fort Scott Community College associate degree in nursing program
 - You may begin your associate degree and bachelor's degree together and graduate with both degrees at the same time - or start your BSN later and progress at a pace that works for you.
- Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.50
 - When calculating GPA, all non-vocational and non-remedial courses from all colleges and universities attended are considered. Except for Intermediate Algebra, remedial courses are not factored into the GPA. Except for associate degree in nursing courses, courses that do not transfer to KU are not factored into the GPA. When a course is repeated, both the original and the new grade are factored into the GPA.
- Completion of 60 credit hours of prerequisite courses with a grade of C or higher, including:
 - **ENGLISH** (2 courses, 6 credits)
 - ENG 1013 English 101 (3 credits)
 - ENG 1023 English 102 (3 credits)
 - **ORAL COMMUNICATION** (1 course, 3 credits)
 - SPE 1093 Public Speaking (3 credits) **or**
 - SPE 2013 Interpersonal Communication (3 credits)
 - **MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS** (2 courses, 6 credits)
 - MAT 1083 College Algebra (3 credits)
 - MAT 2253 Elementary Statistics (3 credits)
 - **NATURAL SCIENCES** (5 courses, 21 credits)
 - NUT 1213 Nutrition I (3 credits)
 - BIO 1245 Microbiology (5 credits)
 - ALH 2263 Pathophysiology (3 credits)
 - CHE 1095 Basic Chemistry (5 credits)
 - BIO 1255 Anatomy and Physiology (5 credits)
 - **SOCIAL SCIENCES** (3 courses, 9 credits)
 - PSY 1013 General Psychology (3 credits)
 - PSY 1023 Psychology of the Human Lifespan (3 credits)
 - SOC 1013 Sociology (3 credits)
 - **ARTS & HUMANITIES** (2 courses, 6 credits)
 - PHI 1023 Ethics (3 credits) **and**
 - One additional course from the Arts & Humanities discipline list at Fort Scott Community College
 - **ADDITIONAL ELECTIVES** (9 credits)
 - You must have a total of 60 prerequisite credits. The courses detailed above do not meet that total, which means that you will also need to complete additional electives of your choice. The electives can be any course listed as transferable on <https://registrar.ku.edu/credittransfer>.
