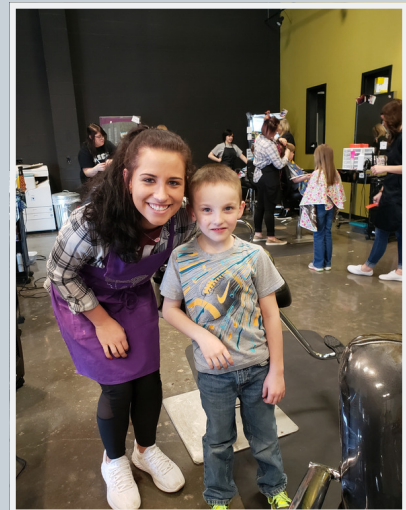
GREYHOUNDS GIVE BACK TO FORT SCOTT!

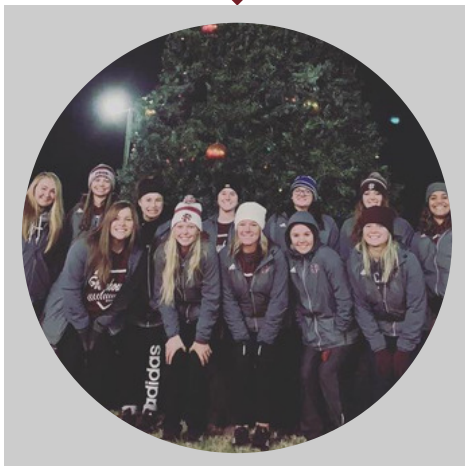

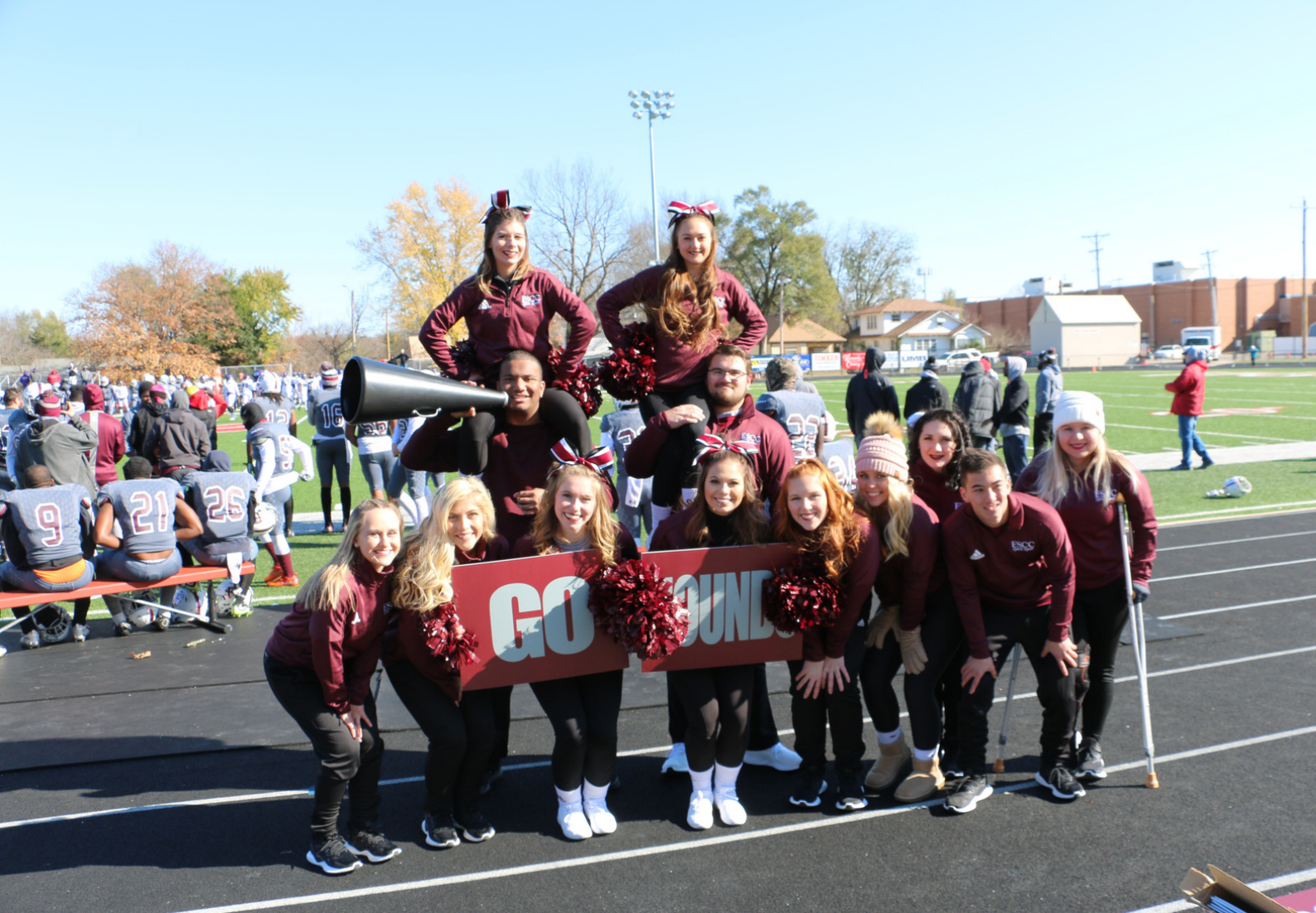
