ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS: To be eligible for admission, you must be admitted to the Fort Scott Community College ADN program for the semester in which you are applying for admission to the KU School of Nursing. If you apply for this program at KU, but are not admitted to FSCC's ADN program, you will not be considered for admission. **You must begin the ADN and BSN nursing programs during the same semester.**

In addition to the application, other requirements include a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.50, three reference letters, a professional resume, and completion of the prerequisite courses detailed below. Admission is competitive; applicants are not guaranteed admission.

When calculating GPA, all non-vocational and non-remedial courses from all colleges and universities attended are considered. When a course is repeated, both the original and the new grade are factored into the GPA. Except for ADN courses, courses that do not transfer to KU are not factored into the GPA.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: The KU application deadline is July 1st for fall of the same year. Students applying for spring admission should contact the KU School of Nursing for details regarding an extended application deadline. Admission decisions are made as applications are received. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply early.

LIBERAL ARTS REQUIREMENTS: The BSN consists of 120 credit hours, including 30 credit hours of KU BSN courses, 31 credit hours from your associate degree in nursing, and 59 credit hours of prerequisite credit hours detailed below. All the prerequisite courses listed below must be completed prior to beginning the ADN program.

Courses with grades of "D" or "F" will not be counted towards the required credit hours. No Pass/Fail courses will be accepted.
